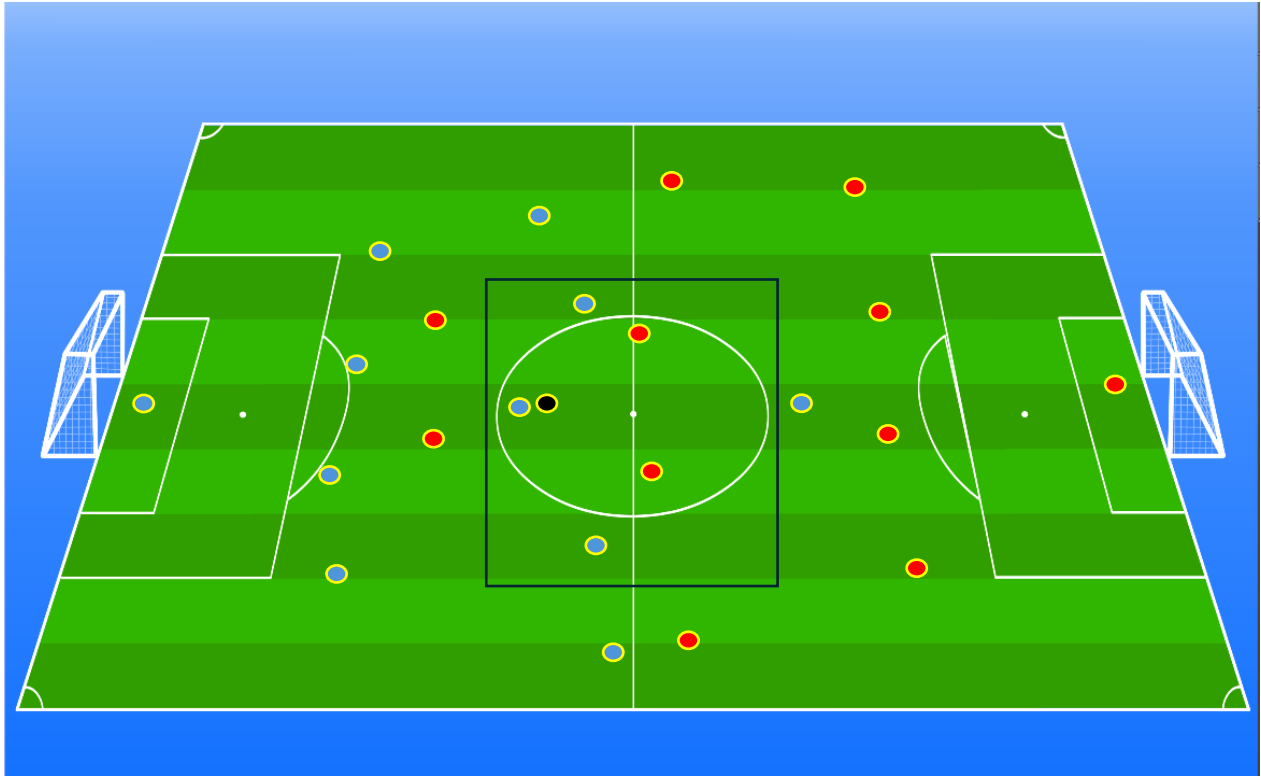


Scenario 1

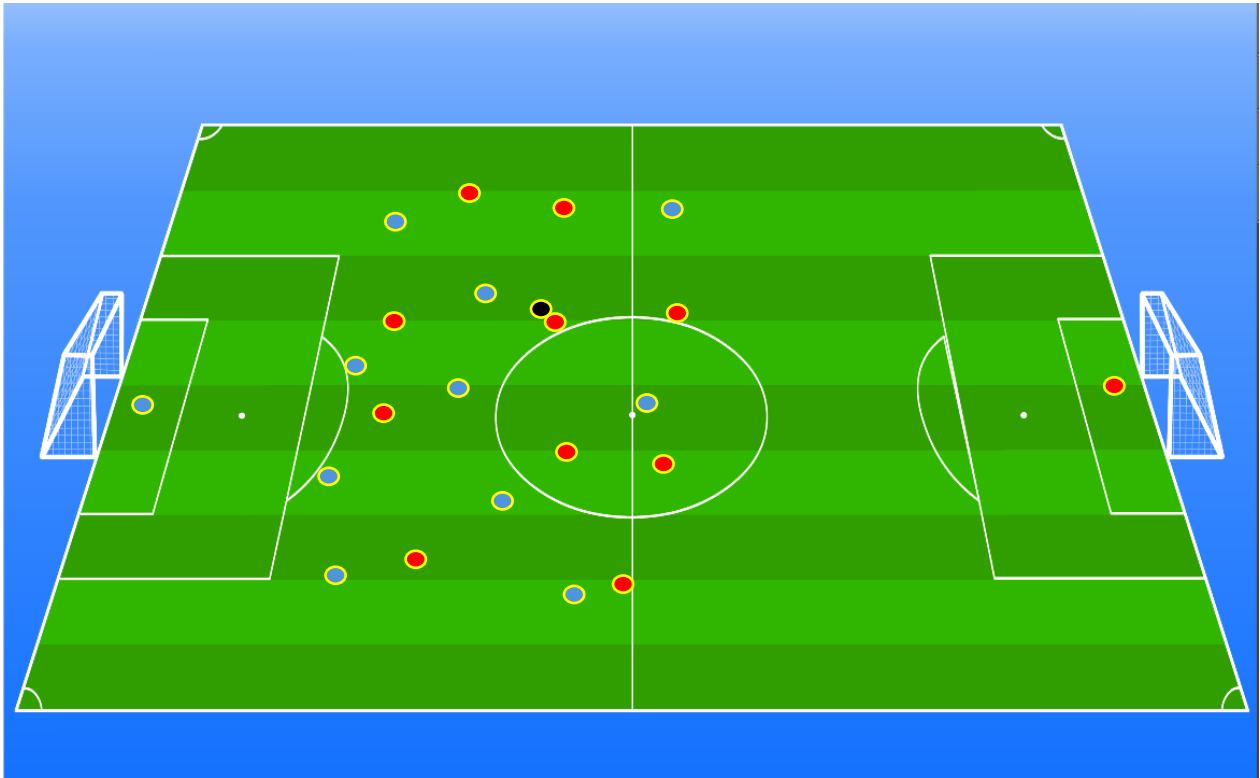

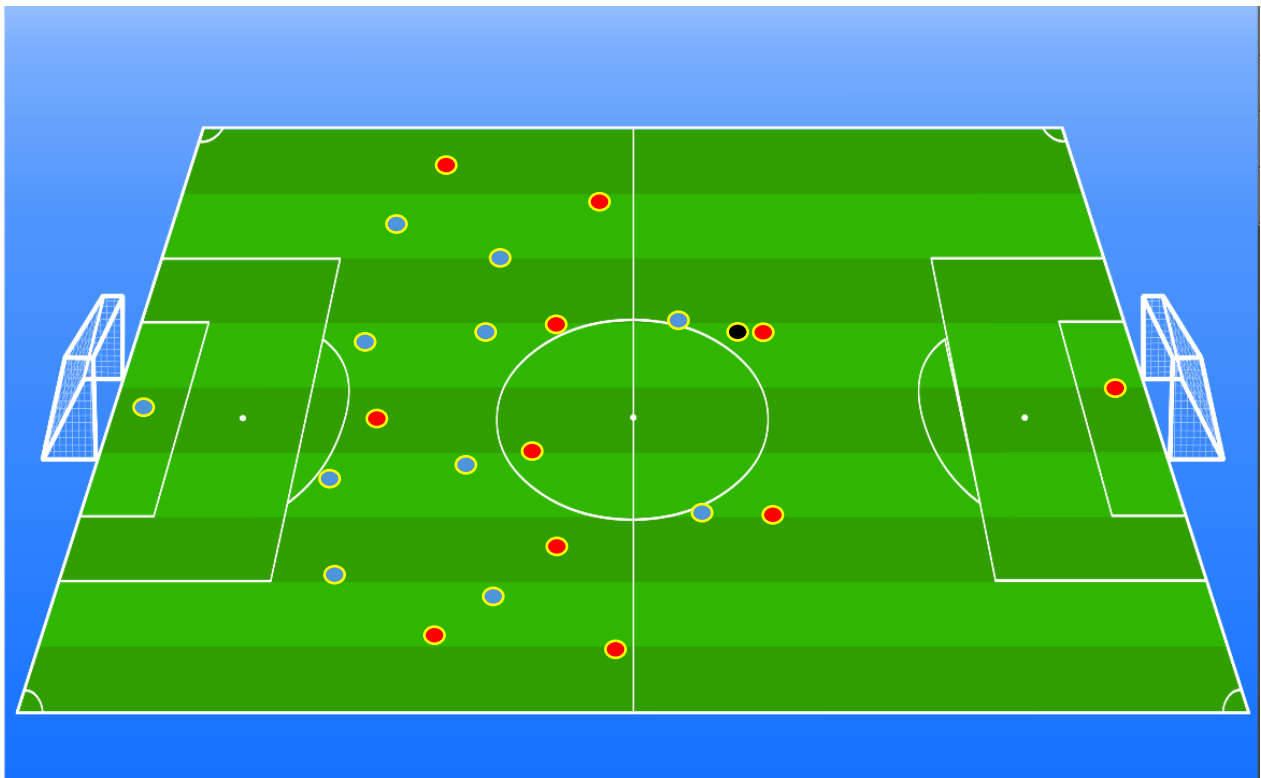

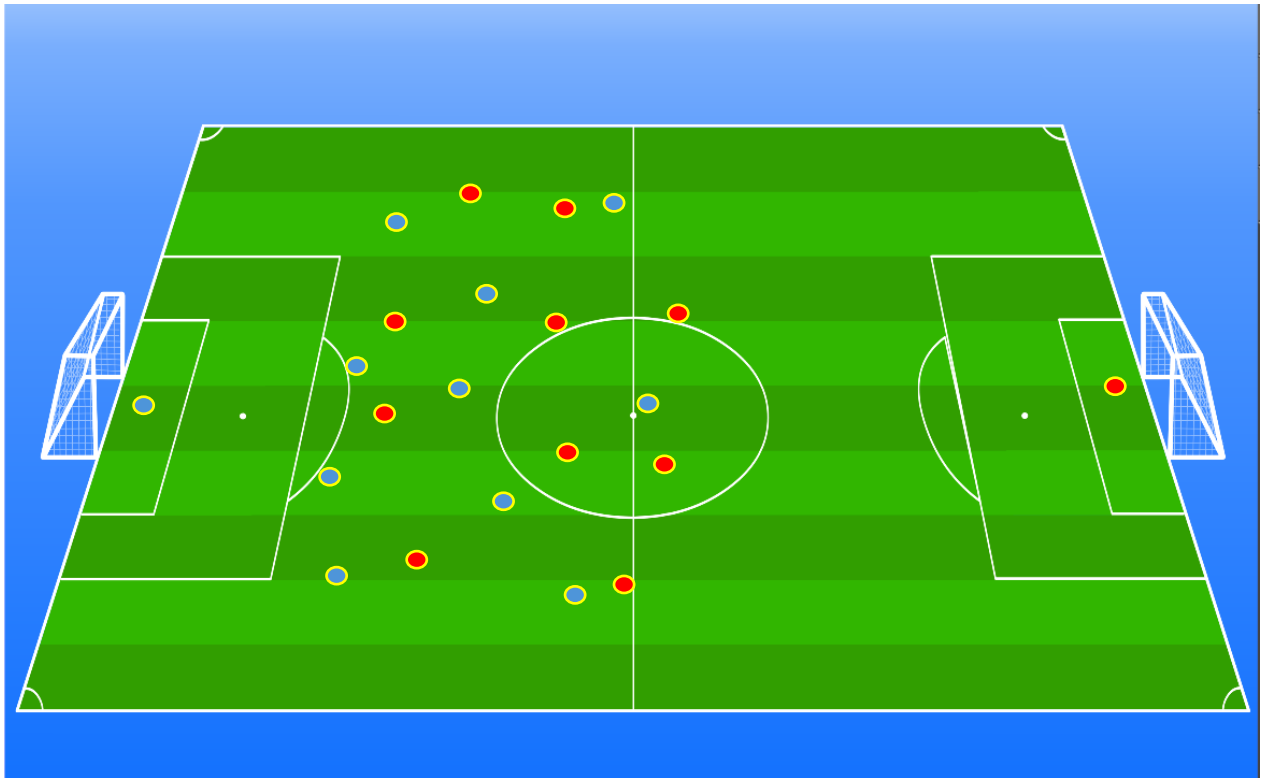
You play a 4-4-2 vs the opponent 4-3-3
