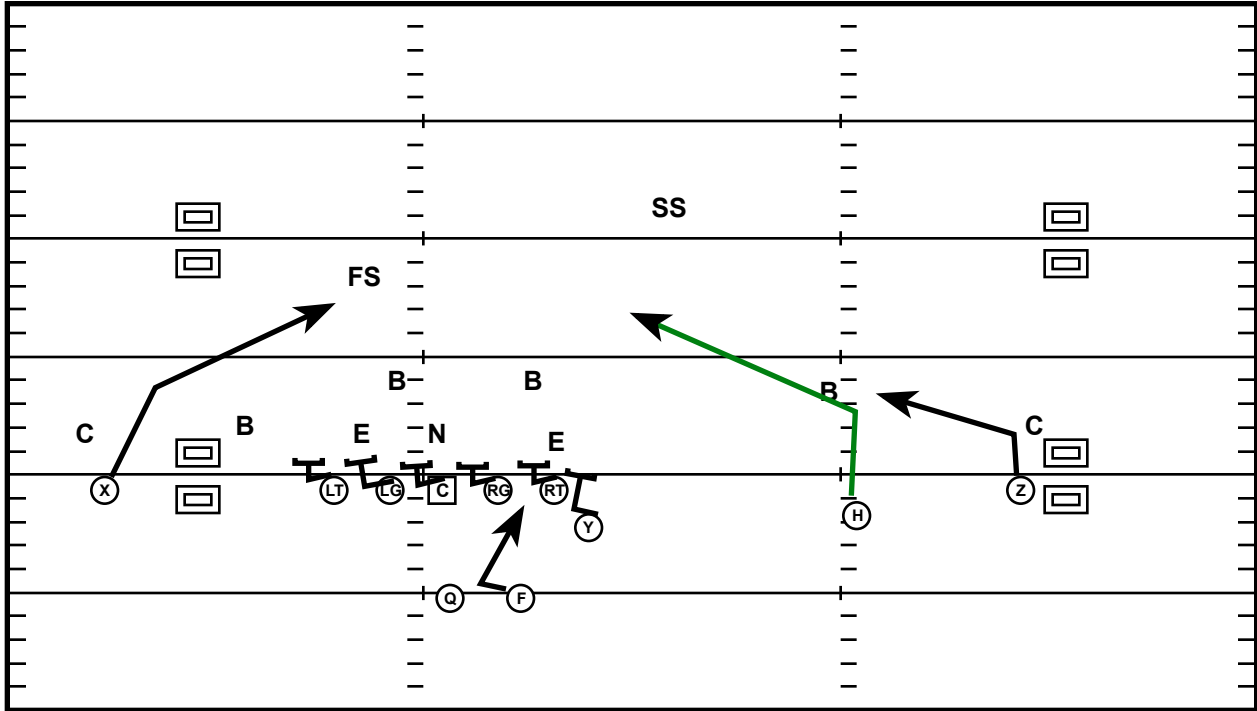

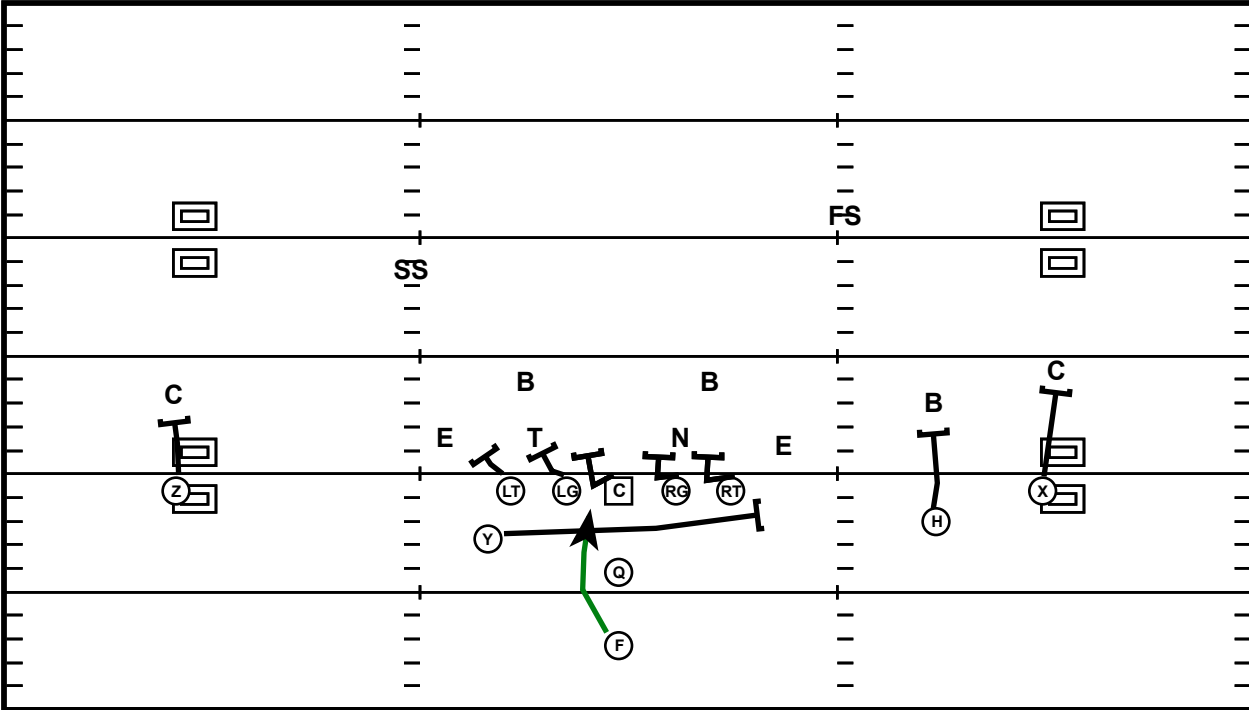

Quick slants with two recievers taking a slightly deeper route (Glance).</p>
