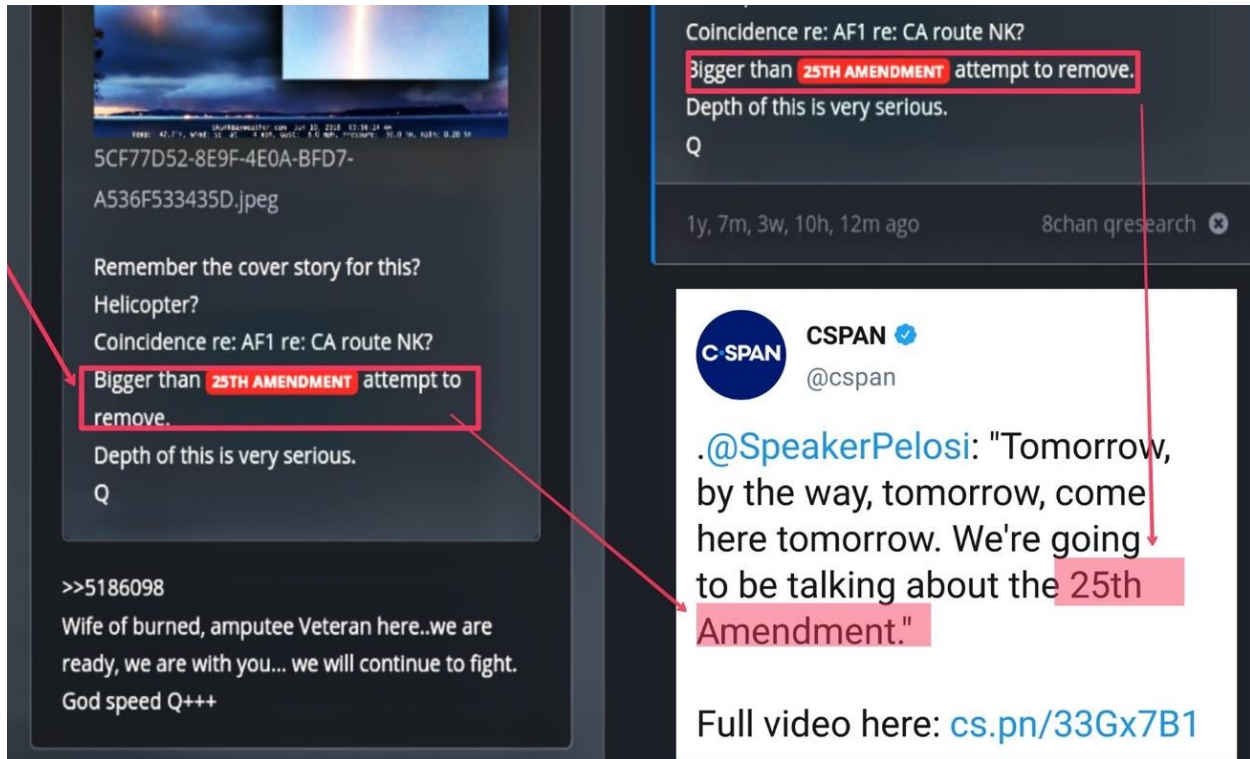

### **Myth 1: The CIA spies on US citizens**

The CIA's mission is to collect information related to foreign intelligence and foreign counterintelligence. By direction of the president in Executive Order 12333 of 1981, and in accordance with procedures approved by the Attorney General, the CIA is restricted in the collection of intelligence information directed against US citizens. Collection is allowed only for an authorized intelligence purpose; for example, if there is a reason to believe that an

individual is involved in espionage or international terrorist activities. The CIA's procedures require senior approval for any such collection that is allowed, and, depending on the collection technique employed, the sanction of the Director of National Intelligence and Attorney General may be required. These restrictions have been in effect since the 1970s.

The FBI has the lead on intelligence matters in the United States, especially those directed against US citizens. The CIA does not collect information concerning the domestic activities of US citizens, but its foreign intelligence collection mission can be conducted anywhere.

The CIA could conduct domestic surveillance with the approval of the DNI.


From that point forward, he knew he had to have people in key positions that he could trust, even if they were not perfectly qualified.

# Mike Pompeo: Clinton emails could be released before election

WASHINGTON — Secretary of State Mike Pompeo on Friday said his agency was working as fast as it could to release Hillary Clinton’s missing emails after President Trump lashed his top diplomat for not making them public.

In an interview on Fox News’ “The Daily Briefing,” the secretary said some of his predecessor’s correspondence could also be made public before the presidential election just 25 days away.

“We’re going to get there. We’re going to get this information out so the American people can see it,” Pompeo said while criticizing Clinton for [using a private email server](#) while she was secretary of state in the Obama administration.

“We’re doing it as fast as we can. I certainly think there’ll be more to see before the election,” he went on.

Pompeo on Friday told Fox News anchor Dana Perino that the release would be done in a way that didn’t threaten national security.

“I’ve been at this with President Trump for four years now, almost. I’ve never seen him do anything that would put any kind of asset, any kind of one of our officers in any harm’s way. He wouldn’t do that,” he said.

“We’ll get the information out that needs to get out and we’ll do it in a way that protects the intelligence sources that we need to protect,” he went on.

Q added “Don’t believe everything you read,” which left me and others confused. Was he saying that the claim by Pompeo was not true?

# Twitter will limit retweets to combat election misinformation

The company also pledges more labels and changes to recommendations.

With less than a month before the US presidential election on November 3rd, Twitter is introducing some [temporary but fundamental changes](#) to how its platform works. In line with recent changes the company made to its [civic integrity policy](#), Twitter says it will label tweets that falsely claim victory for any candidate. Those labels will direct people to Twitter's official US election page. "To determine the results of an election in the US, we require either an announcement from state election officials, or a public projection from at least two authoritative, national news outlets that make independent election calls," the company said. Twitter will also remove any tweets that incite people to violence or otherwise encourage them to interfere with the election.

Another measure will see the company do more to curb the spread of misinformation on its platform. Starting next week, when someone tries to retweet a message that the company has labeled as misleading, they'll see a prompt (pictured above) pointing them to more credible information. Ultimately, users will still have the ability to share these tweets, however.

That said, politicians who tweet out misleading information will see additional restrictions applied to their messages. If a US-based politician, candidate, campaign or account with more than 100,000 followers shares misinformation in a tweet, users will only have the chance to look at that message after seeing a warning from the company. Moreover, their only way of further engaging with the tweet will be to quote tweet it; they won't be able to reply to the message, nor retweet or like it. Additionally, Twitter's algorithm won't surface the tweet in users' timelines. "We expect this will further reduce the visibility of misleading information, and will encourage people to reconsider if they want to amplify these tweets," the company said.

## Nearly 50,000 Ohio Voters In 1 County Receive Wrong Absentee Ballots, Officials Say

Nearly 50,000 voters in Ohio's largest county received absentee ballots with incorrect information, election officials said Friday.

Franklin County elections officials said new ballots for 49,669 voters would be ready to mail within three days, **FOX News** reported.

"We want to make it clear that every voter who received an inaccurate ballot will receive a corrected ballot," the election board **said** in a news release. "Stringent tracking measures are in place to guarantee that a voter can only cast one vote."

Democrat pollster John Zogby says the mainstream media polls are wrong, because they're using D+ 15 and D+16 samples, meaning 15 – 16 percent more Democrats are expected to vote versus Republicans. Zogby says Biden's lead is 2 percent is a more realistic number based on his D+ 4 sample of 38 % D, 34% R turnout.

# Charge: It's a 2-point race, not 16, pro-Biden media polls trying to suppress Trump vote

Add John Zogby to the growing number of Democratic pollsters questioning major media surveys showing a double-digit lead by Joe Biden over President Trump.

"It's closer than you think," according to Zogby, who's own [John Zogby Strategies](#) survey puts Biden's lead at two points, 49%-47%.

In his latest podcast with son and pollster Jeremy Zogby, John Zogby said that polls showing a bigger Biden lead are using a bad model, one that includes far too many Democrats.

His model follows the partisan turnout in 2016 that was about 34% Republicans and about 38% Democrats.
