
#### REDZONE REMINDERS

- When we cross the 50 yard line, expect to score. Expect Shots, nakeds, screens, pap, runs. Protection is at a premium
- AVOID SELF INFLICTED NEGATIVES (SINS), MENTAL ERRORS, PRE-SNAP PROCEDURE PENALTIES, DROPS AND MISSED THROWS
- QB MUST AVOID SACKS THROW THE BALL AWAY. YARDAGE IS PRECIOUS. TAKE THE FG
- EXPECT MORE PRESSURE THE CLOSER YOU GET TO THE ENDZONE
- WR's MUST DEFEAT MAN TO MAN

## THE CLOSER WE GET TO THE END ZONE

- THE SMALLER THE ZONES AND
  WINDOWS GET, SO QB HAS TO BE
  MORE ACCURATE. PUT THE BALL ON
  WR'S BODY
- THINK TD, CHECK DOWN THE RB IS YOUR FRIEND!
- THINK PLAYERS, NOT PLAYS
- THE LEAST DEFENDED PART OF THE END ZONE IS THE BACK 2 YARDS.
