We hereby set the following schedule for any proceeding that may come before this Court. The notice of appeal shall be filed by 3:00 p.m., Wednesday, July 5, 2023. If a habeas petition is to be filed, it is due by 3:00 p.m., Wednesday, July 5, 2023. The record on appeal shall be filed by 9:00 a.m., Thursday, July 6, 2023. The initial brief on the merits shall be filed by 9:00 a.m., Monday, July 10, 2023. The answer brief on the merits shall be filed by 3:00 p.m., Wednesday, July 12, 2023. The reply brief on the merits shall be filed by 3:00 p.m., Friday, July 14, 2023. Oral argument, if necessary, will be scheduled at a later date.
