



# RELOAD DASH PASS SPIKE

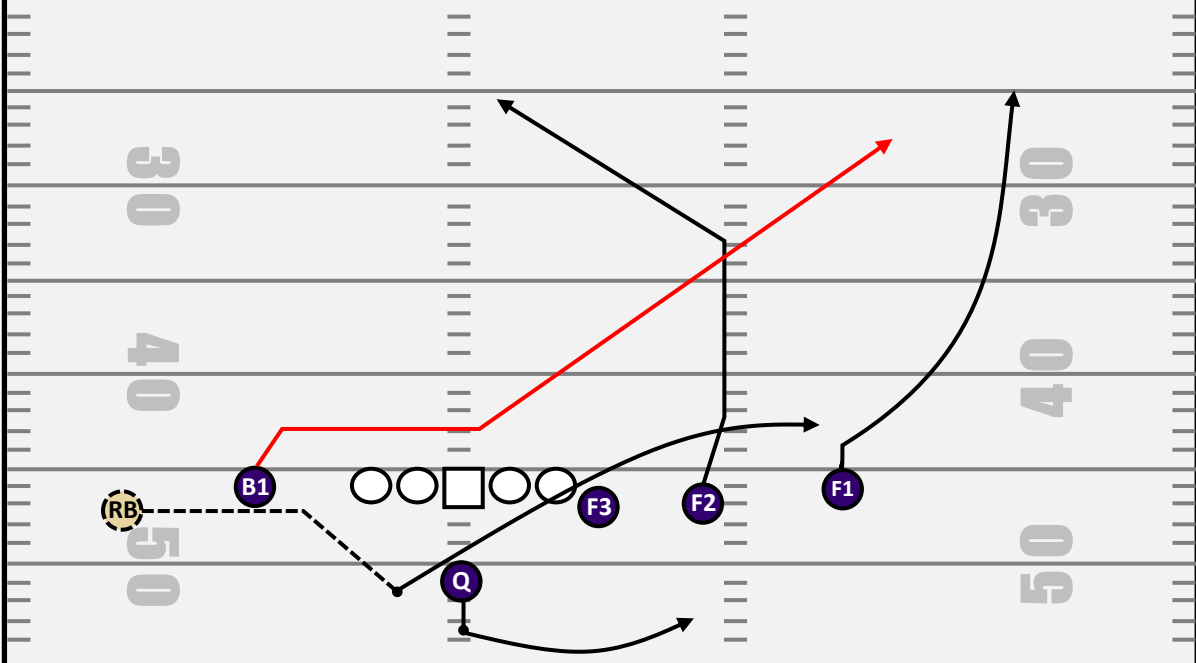
**CORE CONCEPT:** FLOOD  
**SPECIFIC CONCEPT:** FLOOD WITH THE INTERMEDIATE ROUTE COMING FROM THE BACKSIDE SINGLE WR  
**NOTE:** QB UTILIZES DASH PASS FOOTWORK, SETS UP, THEN BOOTS OUT.

## NOTES

MICHIGAN STATE IS IN A 4-2 BOX PLAYING MATCH QUARTERS BEHIND IT.  
 PRE-SNAP THE WLB SHOWS BLITZ, AND COMES ON THE SNAP.  
 THE BOUNDARY-CB CHASES THE SHALLOW FROM B1, WHICH IS A RULE BREAKER IN MATCH 1/4's, COULD BE A COVERAGE BUST OR A TRUE MAN WITH ZONE BEHIND IT.

THE MOR CLEARS OUT THE CB, AND DRAWS THE ATTENTION OF THE FIELD-SAFETY.  
 THE POST TAKES THE NICKLE TO THE OPPOSITE HASH.  
 THE RB FLAT ROUTE PULLS THE MLB TO THE FLATS.  
 THE ONLY DEFENDER WHO CAN PLAY THE SPIKE ROUTE IS THE CB IN MAN COVERAGE WHO TRIES, BUT GOT SHOOK ON THE SPIKE AND CLIMB OF THE RECEIVER.

THE PLAY RESULTS IN A 25-YARD EXPLOSIVE.
